Divisions:

Boys - K/1/2/3-4/5-6/7-8 Girls - K/1/2/3-4/5-6/7-8

Points: 1st place - 5 pts, 2nd - 3 pts, 3rd - 1 pt

There is a maximium of 3 events per athlete. K-12 athletes may participate in either the 50 or 100 and one field event. Relay TBD be team coach.

\$10 entry fee per athlete until 3/27. Walkons will be accepted on 4/12/15 from 8am-10am with a \$25 entry fee. Checks made payable to PLHSPA / POP.

All athletes must register thru their school site. Ribbons will be given after each heat. Medals will be given to overall event winners. Trophies will be awarded to the winning school in each division.

Running Events - The first race is 9:00am. There is no set time schedule; the next event begins when the previous event ends. Athletes must be ready and listen for the Check In Calls ove the PA, any athlete who shows up after Final call will be scratched from event. (K-2nd graders may participate in the 50 or 100 and one field event.)

## Field events

Other than 9:00am, there is no time schedule; the next event begins when the previous event ends. Athletes must be ready and listen for the Check In calls over the PA. Any athlete who shows up after final call is scratced from event.

- Long jump (3-4) (5-6) (7-8)\* 2 jumps per athlete
- Long Jump (K-2)
  - \*1 jump per athlete
- High Jump (3-4) (5-6) (7-8)\* 3'0" starting height
- Shot Put (3-4) (5-6) (7-8)\*3 throws per athlete
- Softball Toss (K-2) \*2 throws per athlete
- Soccer Shoot (K-2)
   \*2 shoots per athlete

K-2nd graders may participate in one Field event All Field events will be girls first, boys second, except High Jump which is co-ed in each Divison \*3-8 Girls and 3-6 Boys will use 6 lb shot \*7-8 Boys will use 8.8 Shot

Spectator fees: \$3 or two for \$5 / students 12th grade and under are free. All students must register through their school site.
