- They are in transition. The fact that the test scores are indicating the classes are the same is a great sign since it is new and will get better more.
- Fell apart because of no devices, not enough teacher training, not the right teachers,
- To support the continuation of the program David Lorden can facilitate a meeting with both schools and cluster members to convince teachers to continue. Kids to comment on program.
