Governance

John deBeck: Athletics is a perfect place for the cluster synergy to begin. Keep talking to each other as it may lead to some other things for this cluster.

Cluster Governance Model:

Our 2010 budget book says our ten school budget is 36 million dollars (not including district overhead)

We've talked about several different governance models: charter (for Correia due to program improvement), Cluster wide charter, create school district, cluster governance.

We are ONLY talking about cluster governance now. Possibly over program, budget etc.

Questions:

What part of the 25 million that may be our part of the district overhead can we use in a more effective way? John deBeck agrees. He also believes we should explore what part of the money is in the district tax base.

Can we get a cluster wide SSC?

Question for John DeBeck. Do you think they will give us control over some of the other monies?

A: No

deBeck continues: Categorical monies are non restricted. Strategy to get our share of the district money we would need to convince all the board members to believe that cluster governance is the way to go for their communities. Equity may be an issue
