Funding formula brings us up to average per pupil funding (currently at 8,500, proposed state funding would bring us up to 11,000). There was an OB Town Council meeting at OB Elementary regarding enrollment predictions for this year (70 kids left the boundaries this year). One of the displaced teachers was picked up at Sunset View Elementary since they needed to add a teacher. 118 elementary schools in SD Unified- 45 gained teachers, 28 lost, 45 stayed same. The AC units that were sent last year can't be installed at several of the schools due to awning windows. The district is still finalizing plans for AC to be provided. The funding source or timelines for the AC is still not ironed out.

5. Constant Contact; eBlast funding/Banner Bank Grant - Suzy Reid

Following schools are using constant contact: OBE, Loma Portal, PLHS, Correia, Dana. The district is now providing a program for school use. We pay for the service by the number of emails users. Schools in the cluster are requested to contribute for the service (\$100/elementary, \$200/middle & High). School Messenger can't be used to discuss requests for funding, so continuing constant contact may be useful. There are features (polling) that aren't being used currently that might make the service more attractive. There are also other companies that provide the service now. Recommend looking at all features and other providers for next year.
